**PUBLIC HEARING
ON NUISANCE ABATEMENT**

The Council of the Town of Monon met for a public hearing on Monday, September 18, at 5:00 pm at the Monon Town Hall. Members present were President Rosemary Cooley, Ken Hickman, Toni Onken and Chris Franklin. Also, present were Marshal Roger Young, Attorney Rebecca Trent, and Clerk - Treasurer Stacy Selagy.

-Vice-President Ron Benakovich was absent.

-President Rosemary Cooley started the public hearing @ 5:00 pm.

Attorney Trent began the meeting by stating that on August 3rd, 2023, the Town of Monon sent an order to Jacob Garling, owner of 103 N Arch St, to remove two outbuildings. The buildings are dilapidated and there are vermin inhabiting them, making them a health and safety risk. The town has also received complaints from a neighbor.

Mr. Garling feels that while not aesthetically pleasing to the eye, the buildings are structurally sound.

After discussion, the board requested that Jacob cut down the mulberry trees and weeds so that the town can get a better view of the structures. Jacob has been granted 30 days' time to complete this work, at which time the town will revisit this issue.
